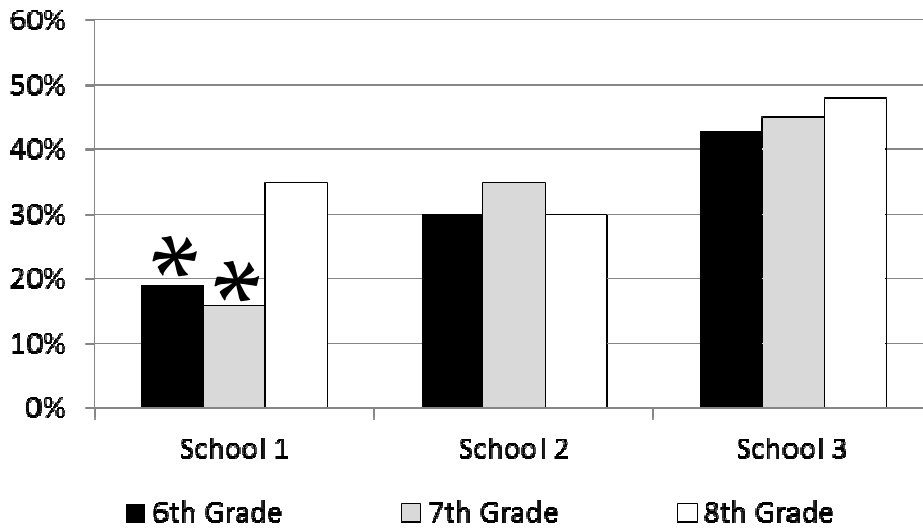


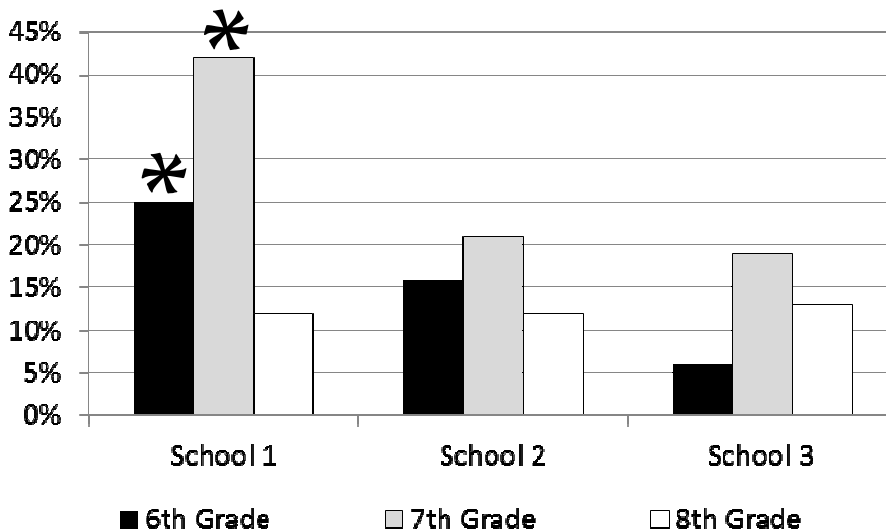
InspirEd TEST RESULTS

In the summer of 2010 a group of 6th and 7th teachers in a small, low-performing, rural school district in Georgia asked to try InspirEd Educators units. Our materials were thus implemented only in grades 6 and 7 in one of three middle schools (School 1 on the graphs) in Liberty County. School 1 had performed about the same as school 2 in 2010 testing, 28% of 6th graders and 33% of 7th did not meet expectations. On the 2011 Georgia Criterion Referenced Test, however, InspirEd made a significant difference in the percentage of students that passed. Plus, the percentage EXCEEDING expectations also increased substantially. (See * below) These results illustrate what we have said all along, "InspirEd units work with ALL students!" They help pull up low-performers and challenge others to excel!
